TPMS (Tire Pressure Monitoring System) LIGHT

- If your TPMS light comes on and stays on and doesn't blink, it usually indicates low tire pressure (See symbol below)



- In some vehicles, the spare tire can also trigger the TPMS if it has low pressure.
- If your TPMS light comes on and blinks or flashes, it indicates a malfunction in the TPMS system.
