



## VACUUM (AIR) LEAKS: A COMMON POWER DRAINER

- One of the most common and often overlooked problems that rob your engine of power is air leaks.
- Air leaks are commonly misdiagnosed, leading to unnecessary part replacements.
- Air leaks happen due to damaged hoses or improperly sealed components that allow too much air into the engine.
- This results in a condition of more air relative to fuel, causing performance problems.
- If you have performance problems, request that your mechanic performs air leaks as one of the primary checks.
