BRAKE FADE – A DANGEROUS PHENOMENON

- Brake fade refers to a condition when your braking system loses its efficiency due to heat buildup.
- There are several types of brake fade.
- The most common is ‘friction fade’ which occurs when frictional materials such as the brake pads and brake shoes become excessively hot-reducing braking power.
- To avoid friction fade
 - Use only quality braking components.
 - Avoid hard continuous application of brakes at high speeds.
