



## **COOLING DOWN THE TURBOCHARGER**

- Turbochargers run at speeds in excess of 100,000 rotations per minute, generating extreme amounts of heat in the process.
- When you get to your destination, it is advisable to keep your engine idling for about a minute if you have a turbo charger.
- Doing this keeps the oil circulating through it to help cool it down more effectively.
- This can also help extend the life of your turbocharger.
