UNDERSTANDING THE CHECK ENGINE LIGHT

- No one likes to see their check engine light (CEL) come on.
- The check engine light may be solid or blinking.
- **SOLID CHECK ENGINE LIGHT:** Your vehicle is telling you it has a problem that needs attention as soon as possible. Usually you can keep driving but you should address the issue at the earliest opportunity.
- **BLINKING CHECK ENGINE LIGHT** Your vehicle is telling you there is serious damage being done right now. If you have a blinking CEL, stop driving as soon as it is safe to do so and have the vehicle towed to a repair shop or looked at by a qualified mechanic.
