UNDERSTANDING OIL VISCOSITY

- Labels such as SAE 5W-30, SAE 0W-30, SAE 10W-40 are found on oil containers.
- But what do they mean and how should they inform your purchasing decisions?
- Consider a gallon of oil that reads 'SAE 5W-30'. SAE stands for Society of Automotive Engineers. 5 and 30 refer to the oil's viscosity (thickness) and W stands for Winter.
- This means during the Winter season the viscosity of the oil is 5 and during hot seasons (or engine operating temperature), the viscosity is 30.
- If you live in a tropical country like Ghana and your car calls for SAE 5W-30, you can use SAE30 as if available.
