## COMMON SIGNS OF BRAKE PROBLEMS

- If you experience any of the following issues, you're encouraged to address them before a 300 GHS repair turns into a 3000 GHS repair.
- **Noise:** If you hear screeching, grinding or clicking noises when applying the brakes.
- **Pulling:** If your vehicle pulls to one side while braking.
- **Low Pedal:** If your brake pedal touches the vehicle floor before the vehicle stops.
- **Hard Pedal:** If you must apply extreme pressure to the brake pedal before the brakes engage.

## COMMON SIGNS OF BRAKE PROBLEMS

- **Grabbing:** If your brakes grab or seem to be holding on to something at the slightest touch to the pedal.
- **Vibration:** If your steering wheel vibrates, when you apply your brakes.
- **Light:** If the brake light stays illuminated on your vehicle's dashboard after vehicle startup and parking brake disengaged.
- **Low Brake fluid:** If your brake fluid is at or below the recommended minimum level.
