## **COMMON SIGNS OF BRAKE PROBLEMS**

- If you experience any of the following issues, you're encouraged to address them before a 300 GHS repair turns into a 3000 GHS repair.
- **Noise**: If you hear screeching, grinding or clicking noises when applying the brakes.
- Pulling: If your vehicle pulls to one side while braking.
- Low Pedal: If your brake pedal touches the vehicle floor before the vehicle stops.
- Hard Pedal: If you must apply extreme pressure to the brake pedal before the brakes engage.



## **COMMON SIGNS OF BRAKE PROBLEMS**

- **Grabbing**: If your brakes grab or seem to be holding on to something at the slightest touch to the pedal.
- Vibration: If your steering wheel vibrates, when you apply your brakes.
- **Light**: If the brake light stays illuminated on your vehicle's dashboard after vehicle startup and parking brake disengaged.
- Low Brake fluid: If your brake fluid is at or below the recommended minimum level.
