BATTERY DISCONNECTION AND VEHICLE PERFORMANCE

- Have you ever disconnected your car battery only to find out after reconnecting that you lost your preset radio stations?
- In today's modern vehicles you lose more than just your radio stations. Most modern vehicles are electronic marvels with some vehicles having upwards of 30 computers- making them susceptible to memory loss.
- Most modern vehicles learn and store your driving habits and patterns.
- The vehicle then uses that information to improve performance and fuel economy.
- When you disconnect your battery all of that information is cleared and a re-learning period is necessary to restore performance. This re-learning process is called Adaptive Learning.
- It usually takes at least 5 miles (8km) of driving for the vehicle to regather basic information about your driving habits after a battery reconnection.
